



10 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT TYBURN ACADEMY

1. NY STATE ACCREDITED, PRIVATE, INDEPENDENT CATHOLIC SCHOOL

Our students earn NYS Regents or Advanced Regents Diplomas. We have AP and CCC courses and all of our core courses are offered as honors courses.

2. ABOVE AVERAGE TEST SCORES

Our test scores, including SAT & ACT scores, are higher than the area average, NYS average, and national average. 99% of our students score in the proficient range on the English 11 regent exam, this includes all of our students, such as those with an IEP or 504 Plan. Our proficiency rates are significantly higher than other area schools.

3. 100% GRADUATION RATE

Upon graduation our students go on to colleges & universities, military service, missionary work and some contemplate religious vocations. Our students have received sizeable scholarships to competitive colleges, such as Providence, Penn State, Catholic University, Notre Dame, Colgate, Syracuse University, Hobart and William Smith, Grove City, Upstate Medical University, RIT, Clarkson University, and the University of Rochester, just to name a few. Many of these are full ride scholarships and many are granted during their junior year. 85% of our students receive scholarships! Our students also have received Congressional nominations to the Naval Academy, West Point, and the Air Force Academy.

4. TUITION ASSISTANCE

We offer tuition subsidies and scholarships with open enrollment throughout the year.

5. DIVERSITY

We have students of all faiths, from all socio-economic backgrounds, and at all levels of learning and achievement. Our students come from Auburn, Union Springs, Port Byron, Aurora, Lansing, Moravia, LaFayette, Skaneateles, Weedsport, Syracuse, Seneca Falls, and Phelps, among others.

6. THE HERITAGE LEARNING CENTER

We provide academic support for all of our students on a regular basis and/or on an as-needed basis. We offer students shadow and internship opportunities at area businesses so that our students can familiarize themselves with professions in which they have interest.

7. OPPORTUNITIES FOR CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Our students can attend BOCES and they can take part in the New Visions Program.

8. EDUCATION ENHANCEMENTS

We have sports, band, choir, theater/spring musical, ski club, SGO, Chess Club, Spanish Club, National Honor Society, Yearbook and Newspaper to name a few. Our students take class trips and we offer trips abroad as well. This spring students will travel to Rome.

9. INDIVIDUALIZED ATTENTION

We offer small class sizes for individualized learning in the classical liberal arts and the sciences. We work with parents to foster the intellectual and moral development of our students.
